or the past three days, I have been part of a group being trained to facilitate a program called "Strengthening Parents and Families" offered by the Council on Chemical Abuse - Berks County. The training has been at Brandywine Intermediate School.

Now, strengthening parents and families is absolutely something that I am all about, but I am out of my depth with those in the room. I am surrounded by individuals -- all females -- who are half my age, have been through the battlefields of social work and education, whose agency "speak" is not my language. I am the old man in the room at 55. Although I have seen blood, sweat, and tears, I feel like an insecure teenager trying to hold his own in the midst of all the cool kids.

Even after all these years, I am amazed at how quickly my insecurities are tweaked; most stemming back to my awkward days as a young adolescent and teenager. And yet, it's not the same because two moments just lifted me up.

You may not realize this about me, but I am an introvert at heart. I work very hard at appearing extroverted and gregarious when all I really ever want to do is hide. So, meeting new people is a challenge for me. One of the exercises on day one of the training was called "blind compliments." A notecard is taped to the participants' back and each person in the room is to write a compliment on everyone's card. The card was for you and for you alone. You didn't know who gave the compliment; simply that the compliment was given.

As I read through them, one stood out "you have the wellspring of life

in you." What could the person see in me that I couldn't?

Day Two. 7:50^{AM}. I am walking down the hall to the conference room at the school. Dazed and confused by the lack of coffee, I am in my own world. As I try and focus on my surroundings, a huge, beaming smile is approaching from the opposite side of the hallway. It's one of our kids.

"Hey!," I say pleasantly surprised.

"Hi Pastor, " she replied.

"I'm going to school today," I said.

"Me too."

And we passed each other and went our separate ways.

That ear-to-ear smile set the tone for the rest of the day for me. Easter came early for me this year. With a blind compliment and a smile, I experienced joy, hope, love, encouragement. I no longer felt the awkward teenager inside. I was now who I am and was meant to be. All because someone offered a kind word and a smile.

Too often, we complicate faith stuff. Jesus came to offer something the world simply does not do naturally. Connection. Connection to God and connection to one another.

And so, all I can do is say "thank you, Jesus."

Thank you for life, forgiveness, hope, a simple compliment, and a beautiful smile. A blessed Holy Week & Easter to everyone. PMilne


